

BSC Student Policies

Term 2/2022 (FINAL)

BSC will return to on-site, in-person classes for all levels at the beginning of Term 2 in July 2022. A limited number of online classes will also be offered for students who prefer to study online. Term 2 of 2022 will be from 18 July–30 December 2022 with a break from October 8–16. The following new policies will be put into effect beginning in July 2022:

1. All students accepted to study at BSC for on-site classes are required to be **fully vaccinated against COVID19** with the administration of two doses of vaccine. Verification of vaccination status will be conducted prior to the first day of class. Masks may be worn at BSC, but will not be required unless guidance from the local government changes.
2. **Class fees** for all students accepted to study at BSC for on-site classes will be **1,000 baht per 6-month term**, or 200 baht per month (1,200 baht total). Class fees will be due during the first week of the term, or the first day of class each month for students paying monthly.
 - A. Students from the same family (siblings) will only need to pay the class fees for one student.
 - B. Students who withdraw from study at BSC during the first month of the term will receive an 80% refund of all class fees paid. After the first month, no refund will be given.
 - C. Monthly incentives: For every student who maintains perfect attendance (zero absences) during one month of classes, 150 baht will be contributed to the BSC Scholarship Fund for Students in Thai Government Schools. For every student who misses only 1 or 2 classes per month, 75 baht will be contributed to the BSC Scholarship Fund for Students in Thai Government Schools.
 - D. Term incentive: Every student who successfully completes the full 6-month term with an attendance rate of 80% or higher (ie., no more than 20% classes missed during the term) will receive a **100% refund of their class fees** at the end of the term.
 - E. Students unable to pay the class fees can apply for a waiver of class fees by speaking with the BSC manager or director. Students approved to receive a waiver of class fees will be required to maintain an attendance rate of 80% or higher.
 - F. There will be no additional fees for classroom materials, workbooks, etc. Optional Saturday activities and supplemental classes may have additional fees.
 - G. There will be no class fees for students studying in online classes.
3. Students who arrive **more than 15 minutes late** for on-site or online classes will **not be admitted to class** unless the student has sent a message or otherwise notified their teacher of the reason for their tardiness prior to the start of the class.
4. Students who are **absent from class more than 6 times per month** without exceptional circumstances (ie., personal accident or illness, need to travel outside of Chiang Mai, etc.) will be put **on probation**, meaning they will be required to meet with their teacher and/or BSC manager and/or BSC director to discuss their attendance and seek solutions for their difficulties in attending classes regularly prior to being allowed to continue studying the next month.
5. Students who are **absent from class more than 30 classes per term** without exceptional circumstances will **not be allowed to continue studying** during the current term. Such students will be placed on a wait list for the next term.
